EXPEDITION SUMMARY

Darwin to Nhulunbuy over 13 days via Katherine Gorge, traversing the Arnhem Highway on our way to Nhulunbuy, his is Aboriginal Land and visitor numbers are restricted, so it's a real privilege to undertake this journey where we take care of all the necessary permits.

We'll camp in some amazingly remote locations and do our best to experience the incredible ancient cultures of the indigenous land owners.

We've booked a private charter flight to take us to Dhipirri Barra and Sports Fishing Lodge, located in the most remote area of middle Arnhem Land. This is a once in a lifetime opportunity to see this country from the air and to catch some incredible Top End fish species. Two nights, a Half Day and a Full Day fishing charter are included along with return flights.

Not many people get the opportunity to see this part of Australia! That's why this expedition is over 13 days, you've come this far you might as well spend a bit of time free ranging and exploring.

A commercial flight will take you back to Darwin (own arrangements) or you're welcome to stay in the truck for another 5 days as we retrace our footsteps, with a last night stop over in Litchfield National Park.

NHULUNBUY TO DARWIN


Return trip will take approximately 5 days travelling up to 230kms per day

Departing Nhulunbuy on Day 13 [25 Sept] and arriving in to Darwin on Day 17 [29 Sept]

TOTAL KM 1100

The return trip will be a 'get there' mission but we can go the long way via Pine Creek to enable a last night stop in Litchfield National Park. There is an additional flat charge of \$4200 [divided by No. of Guests]







A TRIP NOT TO BE MISSED

EAST ARNHEM LAND

12.1825° S, 136.7819° E

1600km in 13 days of pure, raw Arnhem Land. It doesn't matter where you come from, you will leave in awe and wanting more. This trip is designed for the adventurous overland traveller who aspires to experience truly remote areas that not many others have the pleasure of doing.

It's an 8:00am start out of Darwin. First stop is Katherine Gorge where we've planned to do a Two Gorge afternoon cruise.

80kms south of Katherine we hang a left onto the Arnhem Highway. This will be a full day travelling as we push our way north east into Arnhem Land. It's important to note that Arnhem Land is a non-alcohol region. If we want to have a few drinks it needs to be in Licensed premises. We'll find a bush camp somewhere, an opportunity to reflect how lucky we are to be in such amazing surroundings and all it takes is to look skywards to realise it - day or night.

Baniyala Indigenous Experience is yet to be confirmed. The cost of this traditional experience has not been included. We've requested permission and await a response. It's not an easy communication stream to organise these things sometimes.

Wanuwuy (Cape Arnhem) is breathtakingly beautiful, a pristine peninsula on the eastern tip of East Arnhem Land. We journey along an escarpment, over sand dunes and along pristine stretches of beach. The peninsula is characterised by broad white sandy beaches and extensive dune fields met by unusually clear seas and mangrovefringed tidal inlets. We'll camp here for a night before heading into Nhulunbuy and if the Baniyala experience is unable to be arranged we can certainly get here earlier and stay a few more days.



EAST ARNHEM LAND continued.....

Gove Boat Club becomes our Nhulunbuy base, conveniently located to explore and a place where we can enjoy a well earned beer. We'll leave the truck and trailer here whilst we zip over to Dhipirri Lodge, located right in the middle of the Arnhem Land coast. It doesn't get more remote than this.

We've chartered a small aircraft to fly us directly to Dhipirri Barra and Sportsfishing Lodge, the only way to get there. Make sure your camera's fully charged as the Arnhem coast from the air is a photographers dream orr just sit back and marvel as you fill your memory bank.

We arrive mid morning and after some lunch it's straight into it for an afternoon of fishing. This is a wonderful opportunity to catch the mighty barramundi and a wide range of other pelagics. Eat, drink and sleep the night away before another full day of fishing. Note that drinks are on a cash bar basis at Dhipirri.

After two amazing days we fly back to Nhulunbuy and the Gove Boat Club, no doubt in need of some down-time.

*Nyinyikay Indigenous Experience is yet to be confirmed. Again, we've requested permission and await a response.

If the Nyinyikay Aboriginal Experience is unable to be booked, we plan on camping in and around the beaches of Nhulunbuy for the last couple of nights. There's plenty to choose from pristine places like Rainbow Cliffs and Little Bondi Beach.

The expedition concludes in Nhulunbuy and a reminder that you'll need to make your own flight arrangements for your return trip to Darwin [Air North and Qantas]. Don't forget your airport transfer and accommodation in Darwin also.

If you've got the time and you would rather return by road, the truck will travel back to Darwin over 5 days. There is a flat rate additional charge and includes a visit to Litchfield National Park.

If you've always wanted to visit this part of the world but aren't into the Dhipirri Fishing Charter, this can be deducted from the cost of the expedition. Just talk to us.
