



A TRIP NOT TO BE MISSED

CAPE LEVEQUE IN MAY

16.40° S, 122.93° E

The Dampier Peninsula is breathtaking for people from other states or overseas. Experience white, white sand, the bluest of blue shades of water contrasting against the stunning red cliffs. This trip is designed for the traveller with a little less time, but will still get you away from the commercial side of Broome.

We'll start off by visiting the Willie Creek Pearl Farm and do their 3 hour tour, followed by a lunch. This is the perfect introduction to each other as we embark on our short journey together.

We'll free camp along the stretch of beach leading up to James Price Point – take your pick of Barred Creek or Quondong Point. You might even catch your dinner off the beach.

Experience the culture and history of the Lombadina Aboriginal Community. A visit to the Mother or Pearl Church at Beagle Bay is a must as we make our way towards Middle Lagoon. The fishing off the beach is worth a try and if that doesn't work, sit back and watch the setting sun over the water. Crank up the fire, open a nice bottle of wine and if missing out on landing a fish is the worst part of your day, then you've got nothing to worry about. Life's still pretty good.

Kooljaman is the jewel in the Cape Leveque crown. We'll book their rustic beach shelters [subject to availability] for a few nights and just stay put for the next few days. A chance for you to really unwind.

Recharge your batteries and clear your head with a fishing rod in one hand, a beer in the other, swapping stories around the fire pit.

CAPE LEVEQUE IN MAY continued.....

We'll book a couple of Cultural activities with Bundy. He does tours that show the traditional indigenous way of life. There's a very interesting Coastal Adventure Tour included which goes for 3-4 hours where we'll learn about the region's history and hear the Dreamtime stories of the Bardi people. Afterwards we'll try our hand at spearing a fish or mudcrab and cook it up on the beach.

He also does a night fishing tour where we'll experience the marine life at night. Fish for bluebone, coral trout and mangrove jack. Bundy will bring along the spears as we try to catch fish the traditional way. Reef shoes are essential for this activity, or some old runners you don't want to take home.

This might also be an opportunity to launch the tinny as we camp directly beside the waters edge. There's plenty of fish in these waters, so if the sea gods are kind to us we may just catch dinner.

Our last nights accommodation is at Gumbanan Bush Camp, one of the best kept secrets of the Dampier Peninsula. Home of the Davey Family, where their traditions and family are forever an integral part of the Dampier Peninsula. There's nothing booked here so we'll just play it by ear depending on our available time.

Cape Leveque and the Dampier Peninsula are a stunning part of Australia where you will enjoy an amazing 6 days, a mixture of pure relaxation and cultural immersion. We'll get you back into Broome late afternoon, leaving you the weekend to do some other Broome experiences - perhaps a plane trip to the Horizontal Waterfalls or a Camel ride on Cable Beach at sunset.
