


KUNUNURRA TO BROOME TRIP NOTES



A TRIP NOT TO BE MISSED

KUNUNURRA TO BROOME

15.60° S, 128.76° E

We've assumed you've arrived in Kununurra and already seen Lake Argyle, so we've left it out of this trip. This is highly recommended as you won't see another inland expanse of water like it, 20 times the size of Sydney Harbour.

It doesn't matter where you've come from, you will leave the Kimberley region in awe and wanting more and what better place to start than El Questro Station.

We plan on having 2 nights at El Questro. There's so much to do here it's really a case of turn up and take your pick. There's 4WD tracks leading to amazing fishing holes. Birdlife, wildlife, gorges and breathtaking swimming holes – so it's probably best to see how everyone feels before making hard and fast plans. If Zebedee Springs [thermal pools 28-30 degrees] is on the list we'd best get there early to beat the rush and then possibly head off on a self-guided 4WD day, Chamberlain Gorge perhaps or somewhere to have a fish.

As we leave El Questro we go past Emma Gorge and another opportunity to swim or simply be amazed by the landscape.

The fun continues as we make our way to Hairy Dogs Fishing Camp north of Kununurra on the Ord River. We'll cross the Ivanhoe River, an opportunity for that iconic photograph that comes with serious bragging rights around any dinner table. A half day fishing charter is included at Hairy Dogs and if we don't catch a fish in these waters then we shouldn't be fishing.

You just can't beat fresh fish for dinner, so we'll toast the 'fishing gods' as we watch the sunset, sit around the campfire and contemplate how lucky we are to be in the Kimberley.

If the Hairy Dog lets us go, we make our way back to Kununurra in time for the Ord Valley Muster RODEO. Now ask yourself......when was the last time you went to a rodeo? Exactly....! General admission tickets are included but you'll have to pay extra for a Bull Ride....or maybe we'll pay YOU to ride the bull!



KUNUNURRA TO BROOME continued.....

Kununurra to Purnululu National Park [Bungle Bungles] is 400 odd kilometres, so buckle up for a long day in the truck whilst marvelling at the outback landscape. We'll camp inside Purnululu National Park for the next 2 nights. It's an up close and personal view of these amazing bee-hive rock formations and the chance to walk amongst them gives a true perspective of who really is the boss.

Now you're inside Purnululu and depending on how energetic you're feeling, let's plan to do a walk up Piccaninny Creek to the Lookout [approx. 3km] and take in Cathedral Gorge, a natural amphitheatre with amazing acoustics. The return trip will probably take 3-4 hours. Walks of this nature are best done early before it gets too hot. Good sturdy walking boots and a water bottle are essential.

There's also an opportunity to do a helicopter ride over the area if you wish [excluded]. This will require booking well in advance, so if that's your preference let's talk about it and make it happen.

We'll pass through Halls Creek enroute for Fitzroy Crossing. There's not much of interest along this stretch so it's another one of those 'get there' days. Turn up the air-con, put some music on and buckle up......sometimes these 500km days are necessary when you travel outback Australia. Our camp for the next 2 nights will be the Fitzroy River Lodge.

We've allowed for a full day to explore Danggu Geikie Gorge National Park. There are several walking trails and we should do the early morning one hour boat cruise [included].

It's gorge heaven in this part of the Kimberley as we turn off the main drag towards Tunnel Creek and Windjana Gorge. Some of these gorges require a bit of leg work to get into them, but well worth the effort once you strip off and jump under one of many refreshing waterfalls.

Tunnel Creek is where you can choose to walk through a 750 metre underground tunnel, knee deep through permanent pools and returning the same way. Need to take a torch to spot the resident bats and wear footwear you don't mind getting wet or tossing away.

We'll camp at Windjana Gorge. If you're not 'gorged out' by now, there's some beautiful short walks to do. Last night at camp is always full of stories and memories around the campfire. Windjana to Broome is a further 360km so it's a fair drive, passing through the township of Derby. We'll aim to be back into Broome by late afternoon where you'll be dropped off at your accommodation.



GET ON BOARD
